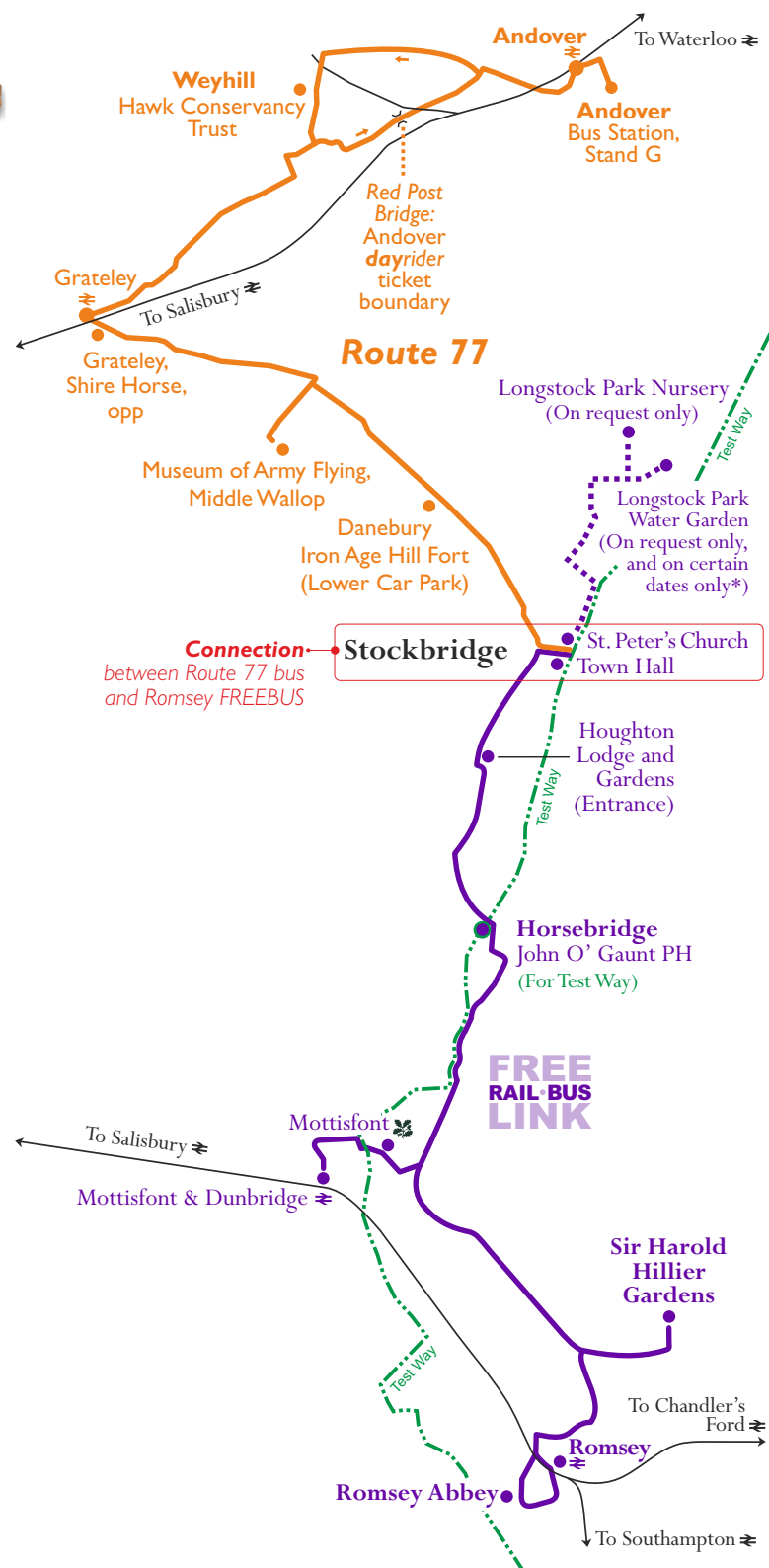

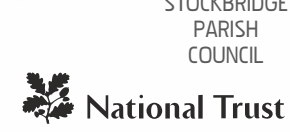


Three Rivers Community Rail Partnership
