FUN FACTS DID YOU KNOW?

Birds of prey have a third eyelid that acts a bit like a windscreen wiper for their eyes.

Eagles are often regarded to be or portrayed as symbols of **power**, **distinction** and freedom.

Most bones in birds are hollow, including the ones in the skull.

Feathers can account for about 14-20% of the total weight of a bird.

Owls have four toes;

a permanent back toe and three front toes. One of these front toes is capable of rotating to the front or back to allow owls to improve their grip on prey once captured.
